4th Quarter Report 2011**

Greetings dear brothers and sisters!



We were able to treat Alina for one of her sicknesses, so, now she is free from coughing, back to normal, praise God. We had to buy the medication in Krasnoyarsk, because we could not find needed medication locally in Norilsk.

Victoria is also getting ill physically, her immune system becomes very weak. The doctors told her that she has to go back to medication, which she did. So, now Victoria is also taking special medication as HIV patient. I feel quite well physically. But all of my family is sick, therefore, please, continue to pray for them. Please, also pray for repentance of my relatives and friends.

Now about the ministry.

Each year we have difficulties with raising funds for Christmas presents for children. However, this year due to our joined efforts with you, we were able to bring happiness to several dozens of children, though some of them do not come to our church. First of all, we made presents for children from our Sunday School. Secondly, we made presents for those teenagers who were in our camp last summer. They were very happy to receive presents from you and our church.



A bit more on Christmas subject. This year we celebrated Christmas twice. First time we did it on December 25, and the second time on January 7 with all the citizens of our country. And my wife and I were able to celebrate Christmas three times, as after the service in Norilsk on January 7, we went to Dudinka, where we continued with celebration of this wonderful event. By the way, I was quite surprised

when I saw that there were 15 people waiting for us in the church in Dudinka. I have to be honest, I have never seen that many people in that church. Even one elderly lady came, who would always sit by the entrance to the block of flats. She said that she came to glorify God with us. That lady came some three hours earlier, and she was just patiently waiting for our arrival. What a lady! After the church service, just like it was in Norilsk, together with the church in Dudinka, we continued our fellowship and praised God around the table. Unfortunately, in spite of the fact that there were few unbelievers in each of the churches, there was no public repentance. Please, pray that the Lord would bring to salvation those people who have heard the Gospel.

Thank you for your prayers for my trips to Krasnoyarsk, Moscow and Novosibirsk. Of course, it was hard to be away from the family and church for almost one month, but God blessed me so



richly during my time in Seminary and at the Conference. Once again I had to review my relationship with the Lord. This was a wonderful time! The next time I travel for my studies would be at the end of April, and I invite you to support me in prayer that the Lord would bless me in that trip. By the way, God has already provided funds to pay my air tickets. Please, pray that I would have a possibility to purchase a notebook computer, which is needed both for my studies and the ministry.

As I wrote in my previous letters, we have already started a group for brothers, where we study material in small groups. Please, pray that in the fall the Lord would help us to start several small groups for spiritual nourishment of church members and for reaching out to unbelievers.

As well as that, we started a group for those who want to be baptized, which is attended by both new converts and people who want to join our church as church members. Please pray for blessings over our brothers and sisters who want to be baptized and who want to become our church members.

Once a month I continue to organize special meetings for men. Praise God that people come in order to learn how to live according to the Bible. Please, pray that the Lord would help each one of us to grow closer to Him.

Please, continue to pray for all of our outreach projects, which I wrote to you about earlier. People call us and they ask for help, but unfortunately, none of them came to church so far. So far we were able to start a course in Math. Soon we plan to start a course in Russian, and in Computer science. Please, pray that unbelievers would come to the church and that we would be able to share the Good News with them.

I thank you for your prayers for the ministry called "Hello, friend!" Each month we receive phone calls to hear the Bible Stories from over 40 children. Please, continue to pray for this ministry in Norilsk, as well as for opportunity to start such a ministry in Dudinka, there are still some difficulties in this respect there.

Thank you for your prayers for our rehabilitation centre. Presently we have 10 people in our centre. Please, continue to pray for further development of this ministry, pray that those who undergo rehabilitation in that centre would come to faith in Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Saviour.

Please, pray that the Lord would provide an opportunity for us to organize another camp this coming summer. As always, we have two major needs: the children and the money, in order to take those children to the camp.

Please, continue to pray for further development of our ministry and revival in Taimir; pray also that the Lord would give us wisdom in the ministry...
